WHAT IS UNP-CAT?

The UNP-CAT is a test given to all students who want to enroll in the undergraduate degree programs of the UNP. It consists of five subtests namely: **Language Proficiency, Reading Comprehension, Mathematics, Sciences and Abstract Reasoning.**

WHO MAY APPLY?

1. Senior students of DEP-ED accredited high schools who are expecting to graduate at the end of the school year.
2. Graduates of DEP-ED accredited high schools or secondary schools abroad.
3. Transferees from other colleges/universities (local or abroad).
4. Those declared eligible for admission to college after taking the Philippine Educational Placement Test (PEPT)
5. Those who failed in the UNP-CAT administered during the **PREVIOUS** years but have not yet taken the re-test.
6. Students who are currently enrolled in the non-degree programs of UNP, and have not yet taken the UNP-CAT.

REQUIREMENTS

A. NEW ENTRANTS or PROSPECTIVE FRESHMEN from DEP-Ed Accredited High Schools

1. Photocopy of form 138 (for students who have graduated high school but not entered college)
2. Correctly and completely accomplished Application Form
3. Two (2) identical 2"x2" recent pictures, colored with red background and name tag
4. Self-addressed and stamped envelope for the mailing of examination results (PRIORITY MAIL-optional)
5. A non-refundable testing fee of PhP180.00
6. Proof of Eligibility for College Admission (for PEPT eligibles only)

B. TRANSFEREES

1. Official Certification of Grades in subjects taken/Official Transcript of Records
2. Correctly and completely accomplished Application Form
3. Two (2) identical 2"x2" recent pictures, colored with red background and name tag
4. Self-addressed and stamped envelope for the mailing of examination results (PRIORITY MAIL-optional)
5. A non-refundable testing fee of PhP180.00

C. FOREIGN STUDENTS

1. Official Certification of all Grades/Transcript of Records/Scholastic Records duly authenticated by the Philippine Embassy or consulate in their country of origin or legal residence.
2. Correctly and completely accomplished Application Form
3. Two (2) identical 2"x2" recent pictures, colored with red background and name tag.
4. Self-addressed and stamped envelope for the mailing of examination results (PRIORITY MAIL-optional)
5. A non-refundable testing fee of PhP180.00
6. Photocopy of Verified Certification of Registration (ACR) for Resident Immigrant Aliens (Bring the Original Copy)
7. Photocopy of Passport and Student Visa for Non-Resident Aliens (Bring the Original Copies)
